The following items are needed: shampoo, conditioner, shaving cream (for men or women), deodorant (for men or women), razors (for men and women), paper toweling, toilet paper, diapers (all sizes), pull ups (all sizes), toothbrushes, toothpaste, laundry detergent, cleaning supplies and facial tissues. Please keep in mind that only full-sized containers are accepted, not hotel sized shampoos, conditioners and soaps.

Door County residents who receive Food Stamps through the state of Wisconsin are not able to purchase these items using their Food Stamps and rely on the help of programs such as Lakeshore CAP's.
