# Dear Friends of United Way:

I find it hard to believe that our annual meeting is already here and it is time to review all of the great things your United Way has done for our community in the past year.

Our Endowment event at the Maritime Museum in February saw over 100 supporters gather to enjoy artwork made by volunteers. Funds raised from this event are put into our endowment fund and each year we allow 5% of the yearend balance to be donated towards programs that are helping others in our community. One of the grants was to the Backpack Buddy Program which sends home healthy snacks to children on weekends; this is facilitated through the local grade schools. Our Day of Action on Saturday, June 19th, brought over 70 volunteers together to help non-profits in our area with Spring clean up or other items that needed doing at their sites.

The Family Wize prescription drug card's ongoing success has put over \$380,000 of prescription drug savings back into the community since its rollout twenty eight months ago.

The Ministry Fall Golf Classic came back in full swing! The weather on September 13th was perfect and Horseshoe Bay was the ideal setting to welcome 100 golfers who enjoyed 18 holes of golf, lunch and dinner. Our Youth Board members sprang into action during campaign and worked with the Sturgeon Bay Student Council to donate \$500 raised by a talent show at the high school.

October brought our 10th Annual Chefs for a Day Event. Over 80 people enjoyed the culinary talent of local volunteer chefs and enjoyed bidding on the many silent auction items. A Roof Sit by a few of our Board members on a (thankfully) beautiful day in November raised money and awareness in the area. Thanks to WDOR who put us the air at various times during the day to help get the word out. Thanks also to Associated Bank for allowing us to perch on their roof for over nine hours in an effort to surpass the goal of \$10,000!

This year we once again presented a Youth Scholarship to a local high school senior. In working with Brown and Kewaunee Counties and HELP of Door County to transition to a new 211 information and referral line. Whew...it has been a busy year!

How did we manage to do all of this? It is all because of YOU! As many of you know, we're in the midst of celebrating our 50th year of being a part of the Door County Community. The funds you donate, the volunteer hours you give, and your understanding of how important it is to have a successful United Way program in your community will allow us to continue to make Door County a better place to live, work, and play!
